All BLS courses must meet Australian Resuscitation Council (ARC) guidelines in order to be recognised by the RACGP. Participants of all RACGP pathways to Fellowship are required to complete BLS courses as outlined in the relevant pathway or program policies. BLS courses must be a minimum of one hour and must cover basic life support of adults.
