In the healthcare industry, and particularly in the long-term care ("LTC") sector, clinical and operational documentation has long been critical for purposes of ensuring appropriate patient care and demonstrating compliance with the myriad regulatory requirements imposed by the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services ("CMS"), as well as state licensing and Medicaid agencies.

Documentation Essentials in Long-term Care

Documentation in long-term care has become increasingly complex as the resident's clinical needs and decision making have become more complex, regulations and surveys more stringent, documentation based payment systems implemented, and litigations/legal challenges have increased. 1 Remember, if it isn't documented, it isn't done!

Long-term Care Nursing: Admission and Medicare Documentation

This documentation is primarily completed by the nursing team members but can also be supported by ancillary team members such as restorative nursing, activities, dietary, and social services. The chronic medical conditions with which the resident comes to the post-acute care facility are a part of the person's clinical picture.
