Causes of testicular cancer. Some factors that may increase a man's risk of testicular cancer include: undescended testicle (when an infant) family history (having a father or brother who has had testicular cancer) personal history - if you have had cancer in one testicle you are more likely to develop cancer in the other testicle. infertility.

Some men with testicular cancer have no symptoms at all, and their cancer is found during medical testing for other conditions. For instance, sometimes imaging tests done to find the cause of infertility can uncover a small testicular cancer.

Testicular cancer is a disease in which malignant (cancer) cells form in the tissues of one or both testicles. The testicles are 2 egg-shaped glands located inside the scrotum (a sac of loose skin that lies directly below the penis).The testicles are held within the scrotum by the spermatic cord, which also contains the vas deferens and vessels and nerves of the testicles.

In treating testicular cancer , radiation is used mainly to kill cancer cells that have spread to lymph nodes. Radiation therapy, in which a machine sends radiation to a specific part of the body is known as external beam radiation .

Development of a second cancer (like leukemia) is a very serious but rare side effect of chemo, occurring in less than 1% of testicular cancer patients treated with chemo. People who've had

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chemo for testicular cancer seem to have a higher risk of heart problems later in life.

Testicular cancer accounts for 1% of all new cancer cases in males in the UK (2017). Testicular cancer accounts for less than 1% of all new cancer cases in females and males combined in the UK (2017). Incidence rates for testicular cancer in the UK are highest in males aged 30 to 34 (2015-2017).

Testicular cancer may be treated with 1 to 4 cycles of chemotherapy, depending on the stage of the cancer. During treatment, a patient may receive 1 drug at a time or a combination of different drugs given at the same time.
